The following chart shows the dependencies between the minor courses. The numbers shown in second lines in the boxes indicate the number of units for the course.

Note that the number of units for prerequisites for electives will vary depending on the choice of electives and on the major of the student. For example, a Computer Science student has to take prerequisites for COMP350 in the major, so no additional units are necessary. A student from another major wanting to take the same course will have to satisfy the course entry requirements by taking additional courses. Similarly, Computer Science Students will have to satisfy the entry requirements for electives outside of their program. Nevertheless, the majority of students taking the minor will be able to stay within the 24 unit boundaries.
